A Message from our Leadership

York Day Nursery is proud of the accomplishments we have made in the past year. In our ninety-year history, we had never expanded our services beyond one building, and this year we did just that. While the country wrings its hands at how to make childcare accessible and affordable to working families, York Day Nursery got to work and made it happen. Because of our new location at York County School of Technology, an additional seventy children are receiving care at York Day Nursery.

Not only did York Day Nursery

show up for working families this year, but we also showed up for our teachers. By raising our starting wages to \$15 per hour and adjusting our pay scale accordingly, we've turned what was once a steppingstone job, into a lifelong career. We know that our services don't work without highly trained, dedicated employees, and this decision is a testament to our commitment to them.

This year also gave us time to reflect on what ninety years has taught us. As we re-discovered our history, we were struck by the tenacity of our founder,



Netta Ford, as she launched a door-to-door campaign to open our doors in 1932. We were moved by the commitment of Arthur Thomas who, in 1946, facing a devastating funding cut, formally established York Day Nursery and Kindergarten with a committee of local supporters. And finally, we were inspired by the community members who stepped up in 2021 to help us open the doors at our new location.

Our history if one of perseverance. We continue to be guided by a cause we know to be good and just. Early childhood education should be high-quality, affordable, and accessible. Because of you, we do just that.



York Day Nursery Celebrates 90 Years

This year, we are proud to celebrate the ninetieth anniversary of the founding of York Day Nursery. Our history is rooted in the tumult of the Great Depression, when Netta Ford, the Director of the York Visiting Nurse Association, dedicated herself to meeting the needs of the day. Knowing that children were the primary victims of the Depression, Netta committed herself to providing a safe, clean, and nurturing environment for the children of working families in the City of York. Originally caring for fifteen children, Netta rallied support for her cause with a door-to-door fundraising campaign which included soliciting donations from local businesses.

Nearly a century later, we carry on Netta's vision through the 180 children we care for every day. Much like in 1932, we are reliant on the generosity of our community to help keep our tuition affordable while delivering a high-quality program. Netta Ford set us on a path that would guide us through nine decades of service to York County. We are honored to carry on her mission.










GROWTH & EXPANSION



When the administrators at York County School of Technology began seeking a partner to operate their on-site childcare facility, they knew who to call. After years of discussion on how to grow and expand, York Day Nursery was ready to seize the opportunity when it came our way.

With the full support of the Board of Directors, York Day Nursery signed a lease to operate this center in May 2021. In August we brought on Sabrina Walters, a local leader in Early Childhood Education, as the Center Director. With Sabrina's help, and with over \$200,000 in

local community support, we were able to open our doors on November 1, 2021.

Today, this center serves 70 children and employs 27 early childhood educators. We have successfully expanded the reach of York Day Nursery and are providing a critical service in a previously under-served community. With 207 children remaining on our waiting list, we know our work is not finished, but we are proud to have moved the needle on access to affordable, high-quality care for working families.

We are so incredibly grateful to be one of the families who were able to enroll at York Tech. To be able to know that your children are cared for by kind, compassionate, loving people is a gift that is indescribable. We love YDN and the things they do for the community.



was awarded from the York Day Nursery Infant-Toddler Scholarship Fund, supporting 40 children.


